Meeting opened by Greg Morlock with a prayer from Pastor Heather Brown.

Secretary's report read

Treasurer's report presented, with all the bills paid except the Parish and Dona Kosel. An additional \$300.00 was given 12/5/11 for the Flood of Love. Change collected each Sunday for this project by the Sunday School children totaled \$375.00

Pastor Brown and Dona Kosel will discuss the Flood of Love contributions with more information to follow.

Balance in the account is \$13,752.33 which includes the Flood of Love Donations.

Both reports were accepted as presented

Peggy Undlin was present to discuss the bills (current and future) for the church.

The installation bill is \$370.00, with ½ being paid by each church. In addition, propane \$2,075.50, water \$177.00 (year), Ottertail approx. 432.00. Each church will pay ½ of the amounts and they will vary. Insurance will be paid in April by the Lutheran Church and in Sept by United Methodist.

Darlene Wenstad will do the lawn mowing in the summer.

A boiler inspection is due in Feb, Bob Kosel will take care of this.

After discussions, Bob Kosel moved to pay the bills with a second by Dustin Undlin.

The steeple and the chandeliers from the Lutheran Church are at the Church at the Threshing Grounds. The electric chair to aid people from the Lutheran Church has been donated to the Easter Seals.

A discussion was held regarding getting new tables for the church. More to follow.

The Sunday School Christmas program is Dec. 11, with a potluck to follow.

New Candles will be purchased to be used at the Christmas Eve program.

Pastor Heather thanked all who participated in the Angel Tree Program.

No church services will be held on Christmas day, but will be on Jan 1, 2012
