

Glenburn Trinity Lutheran Church Council met at 9 P.M. on June 8th. Those present included: Pastor Heather, Denise and Clark Gunning, Mickey Mickelson, Bob Sanders, Missi Payne, and Michelle Schumann.

Denise called the meeting to order. Pastor Heather gave the opening devotions, titled "Who is a missionary?" and the opening prayer.

The secretaries minutes were read. Denise moved and Bob seconded it that the minutes be approved. Motion was carried.

The treasurers report states the balance on hand in the checkbook as of May 31st is \$10,046.21. Noted however was that we have left to pay, for May, the Western N.D. Synod payment of \$1046. And the Lutheran Social Service payment of \$131.

Stated was that the "Spring Challenge" donations so far have amounted to \$3250.

The roast beef dinner final report states the profit was \$2473.82.

\$210.50 in quarters was collected for the Central African Republic project.

Michelle moved and Mickey seconded it that the treasurers report be approved. Motion was carried.

Kari Johnson will be welcomed into our church as a new member sometime possibly in the fall.

As stated, the roast beef dinner profit was \$2473.82. Noted was that there was 80 less people served than last year.

STEWARDSHIP

The "Spring Challenge" of "To strive not to use the mission fund to support the budget" has been a success.

For the project of "God's Global Barnyard", \$53. was collected..

Noted was that a \$25. donation was received to go toward "Mother the Camp".

It was decided that we would allow Steve Files to give communion on June 19th. when he preaches here.

The organist compensation was discussed. It was suggested we increase the weekly payment to \$50. Per Sunday from the approx. \$36.54 per Sunday already being paid. It was decided we would wait until the August meeting to finalize things.

PROPERTY

Noted was that the parking lot remains soft so no one parks on it yet.

Mickey stated the new church cleaner is working out fine.

Mickey will make new keys for the new outside door knob/lock by the bathrooms.

Mickey will contact various local sign businesses to check on the different costs for a new outside church sign.

Mickey bought light bulbs and halogen lights for the church and will soon put them in.

So far we do not know how many of the youth desire to attend Camp Metigoshe this summer. (Each will receive \$50. to help pay the fee to attend).

Metigoshe Day Camp will be July 18 to 22.

The collected food items for “Mother the Camp” need to be taken there yet.

YOUTH

3 youth so far, have expressed an interest in attending the Pine Ridge Mission trip. The cost is \$288. per person. Noted was that there is \$1294.13 in the youth account. Michelle moved and Mickey seconded it that we pay each youth attending \$100 from the youth account to help with expenses. Motion was carried.

Suggested was that sometime in the future we should consider remodeling the women’s bathroom (new paint, wallpaper etc.).
