

Glenburn Trinity Lutheran Council met June 16, 2010 at 7 pm. Present were: Pastor Heather, Mickey Mickelson, Donna Zeltinger, Craig Johnson, Bruce Abernathy, Bob Sanders, Michelle Schumann, Brian and McKayla Christenson. Craig called the meeting to order. Pastor gave the opening devotion and prayer.

The secretaries minutes were read. Noted was that the CANDISC bike run will be in Glenburn Aug. 5th and 6th. Mickey moved we approve the minutes as amended. Seconded by Bob. Motion carried.

The treasurers report states the balance on hand in the check book as of May 31st is \$5719.20. Stated was that the benevolences for Jan, Feb. and March were paid from money from the roast beef dinner. It was stated that we need about \$1500. each week in order to pay all of our bills. At the present, we have usually been receiving 5 to 600. dollars a week. Michelle moved we approve the treasurers report. Seconded by Bruce. Motion was carried.

Discussed was how to get more people to church...especially the more "inactive ones"... in order to inform them of our financial situation and also about the "Simply Giving" program.

Stewardship committee will meet Sunday after church to discuss this topic and various suggestions.

EVANGELISM

The CANDISC Bikers will be in Glenburn Aug. 5th (for supper at 6 to 8 pm) and for breakfast on the 6th (5 to 8 am). A CANDISC community planning meeting will be held later tonight.

Pastor Heather is helping to plan a variety of entertainment for the bikers that evening. It was agreed that we would allow people to camp in the church yard. McKayla volunteered to be in charge of setting up a "quiet room" at the church where a person could go to relax and rest.

YOUTH

Brian spoke on the Camp Metigoshe scholarships. He stated that the youth going into 3rd grade who want to attend the camp, will receive a \$50. scholarship. Other older youth will possibly receive \$75. scholarship.

Pastor stated that in 2011, it is very possible that the youth will go on an Indian Reservation Mission trip to Pine Ridge Reservation in South Dakota, along with youth from Zion Lutheran church in Mohall.

STEWARDSHIP

WORSHIP

PROPERTY

Vote of purchasing a defibrillator for the church was 28 in favor and 9 opposed.

Bob moved and Brian seconded it that we accept \$300. From Michelle Peters for the piano keyboard. Motion carried.

Brian moved and Bruce seconded that we take money out of the building fund to pay for the defibrillator. Motion was carried.
