May 3, 2011

The meeting was called to order by Greg Morlock.. Pastor Heather gave a short devotional.

The total for the roof was \$17,150.00. These funds were voted for on the May 1st meeting held after the church services by the members of the Trinity Lutheran Church.

Peggy Undlin presented some of the bills from the UMC for discussion. At this time Peggy will continue to pay some of these bills with ½ of the money sent at the end of each month, from the Lutheran church.

Dustin will check on putting installation in the attic later this summer.

Bob Kosel will check on getting part of the sidewalk fixed. More information to follow. The UMC church is also checking with the county to fix the parking lot.

The United Methodist Church annual conference will be June 8-11, 2011 in Watertown, SD.

The Welcome Bag that the Lutheran Church has been working on has been approved by the City Council. All three churches will be represented along with the local businesses.

M & M containers will be passed out for quarters by the Sunday school children. These will be turned over to the parish as the funds will be sent to the Central African Republic.

The Sunday school teachers will be recognized on May 15, 2011. We thank Andrea Savelkoul,, Barb Undlin, Rhonda Undlin, Heather Martin, and Teresa Morlock for doing a terrific job this past year. We have a great bunch of children and all are looking forward to a new year.

There were 30 people for the Maundy Thursday, Seder dinner. The Easter worship service had 101 people.
