

Glenburn Trinity Lutheran Church Council met at 8 P.M. on May 18, 2011. Those present included : Pastor Heather, Denise Gunning, Missi Payne, Mickey Mickelson and Michelle Schumann.

Missi called the meeting to order. Pastor gave the opening devotions and prayer from Psalm 52.

The secretaries minutes were read. Mickey moved to approve the minutes. Seconded by Denise. Motion was carried.

The Synod Assembly offering will go toward supporting “North Dakota Lutheran Campus Ministry” and “WND Bible Camps”. June 2,3, and 4th is the Synod assembly meeting. Missi stated she will check to see if she would be able to attend.

Michelle moved and Denise seconded that we give \$25. Each to “N.D. Lutheran Campus Ministry” and to “WND Bible Camps”.

WORSHIP

Michelle stated she would give the sermon on June 26th and David Iverson will lead the other parts of the service.

It was felt that the work groups are working out well.

Discussed was the fact that Karla is actually the “music Director” for many areas other than just being the church organist. It was felt that because she does so much more than just play music during church services that she should receive a larger amount of money every month. This was tabled until the next council meeting.

Noted was that the outside door lock (by the bathrooms) is in need to replacement.

Noted was that last year we gave out \$75. Camp Metigoshe scholarships. Missi moved we give \$50. Scholarships to each person attending. Michelle seconded it and the motion was carried.

Mickey moved and Denise seconded that we renew our copyright license for \$185. Motion was carried.
