

Glenburn Church council met at 8 pm on May 19, 2010. Present included: Pastor Heather, Missi Payne, Michelle Schumann, Craig Johnson, Mickey Mickelson and Bruce Abernathy. Craig called the meeting to order. Pastor gave the opening devotions and the opening prayer from Romans chapter 8. The secretaries minutes were read. Mickey moved to approve the minutes. We have received four camp Metigoshe scholarships for \$50. Each. The youth have been busy fund raising, so it is hopeful that the offered scholarships can be even more.

STEWARDSHIP

It was mentioned that people have been donating toward "God's Global Barnyard" The money given will be collected the first week in June.

would be better since the yard to mow really isn't too big. Michelle moved and Missi seconded it that we purchase from John Hoiland a new Speedster riding lawn mower for \$2500. Motion was carried.

Pastor mentioned that there is a down spout on the east side of the church that is leaking. Mickey will check into it to see what the trouble is.

A letter from the city of Glenburn was received stating that the town is going to purchase a digital sign to be placed over the bank. The cost will be close to \$10,000. They have a request for donations.

Michelle moved and Bruce seconded that we take \$200. Out of the building fund to give to the city. Motion was carried.

The copy right licence renewal is due. The cost is \$185. A year for Glenburn and Lansford together. Glenburn needs to pay 66% of the annual cost. Bruce moved and Mickey seconded that we pay our share of the cost. Motion was carried.
