

Glenburn Trinity Lutheran church council met April 13, 2011 at 9 P.M. in Lansford. Present were” Pastor Heather, Brian Christianson, Mickey Mickelson and Michelle Schumann.

Noted was that a quorum was not present so no voting decisions could be made.

Brian called the meeting to order. The secretaries minutes were read. The check book balance as of 3/31 showed \$5428.45 in the account.
