

Glenburn Trinity Lutheran Church council met October 13, 2010 at 9:40 P.M. Present were: Pastor Heather, Craig Johnson, Michelle Schumann, Mickey Mickelson, Missi Payne , Brian Christianson and Bob Sanders. Craig called the meeting to order. Pastor had the opening devotions and discussed a list of "why I don't come to church" reasons.

EDUCATION:

Missi reported on Kings Kids and stated that the number of children usually attending is 15. Having them meet on Sundays is however, still less than it was on Wednesdays. The need for new teachers still exists.

Bob moved we approve the Sunday schools request for new shepherds uniforms and music (the music totals about \$160.). This would be paid from the memorial fund. Missi seconded it. Motion was carried.

The secretaries minutes were read. Brian moved we approve the minutes. Seconded by Bob. Motion carried.

The treasurers report states the checkbook balance as of 10/13/10 is \$965.59. Noted was that \$1734.47 is due yet to cover the August and Sept. synod and Lutheran social service payments. Discussion followed. Craig will speak in church in a couple of weeks regarding our financial situation. Michelle moved we approve the treasurers report. Seconded by Brian. Motion was carried.

EVANGELISM:

A brochure on Trinity Lutheran church, made by Tori Zeltinger, was passed around. Thank you Tori, for doing such a nice job. These pamphlets will go into the Glenburn welcome bags. We do however need to make copies of it.

STEWARDSHIP:

"Seeds of Faith" Sunday will be Oct. 17th with Bishop Mark Narum preaching and presiding over the church service. A free will basket will be set out for donations to the Seminary Appeal fund.

Bob will call the members of the stewardship committee to set up a date for a meeting.

WORSHIP:

There still is a need for more people to learn how to operate the church's sound system.

Pastor stated that many people have expressed an enjoyment of the occasional contemporary worship service and the variety it brings, but a few have said they do not care for it.

Coffee hour has been a success. Each Sunday, with the free will donations, the youth often receive \$30. To \$40. People have said they enjoy visiting with a cup of coffee and some goodies after church.

PROPERTY:

Karla will make a list of weekly cleaning jobs needed at the church. Pastor will give the list to our custodian.

A list for annual cleaning jobs will soon be set up...for the first week in November.

Noted was that much of the trim around window frames is in need of new paint. Mickey will check to see what paint/stain was previously used.

Stated was that the refrigerator isn't working very well. It tends to shut off at times. Mickey volunteered to call someone to see what would need to be done in order to fix it and if so, how expensive it would be.

It was approved to transfer \$150. From the camp Metigoshe fund to support LYO registration.
